What do you think could be improved? [below is a sample of answers covering the different themes and comments that were given in response to this question]

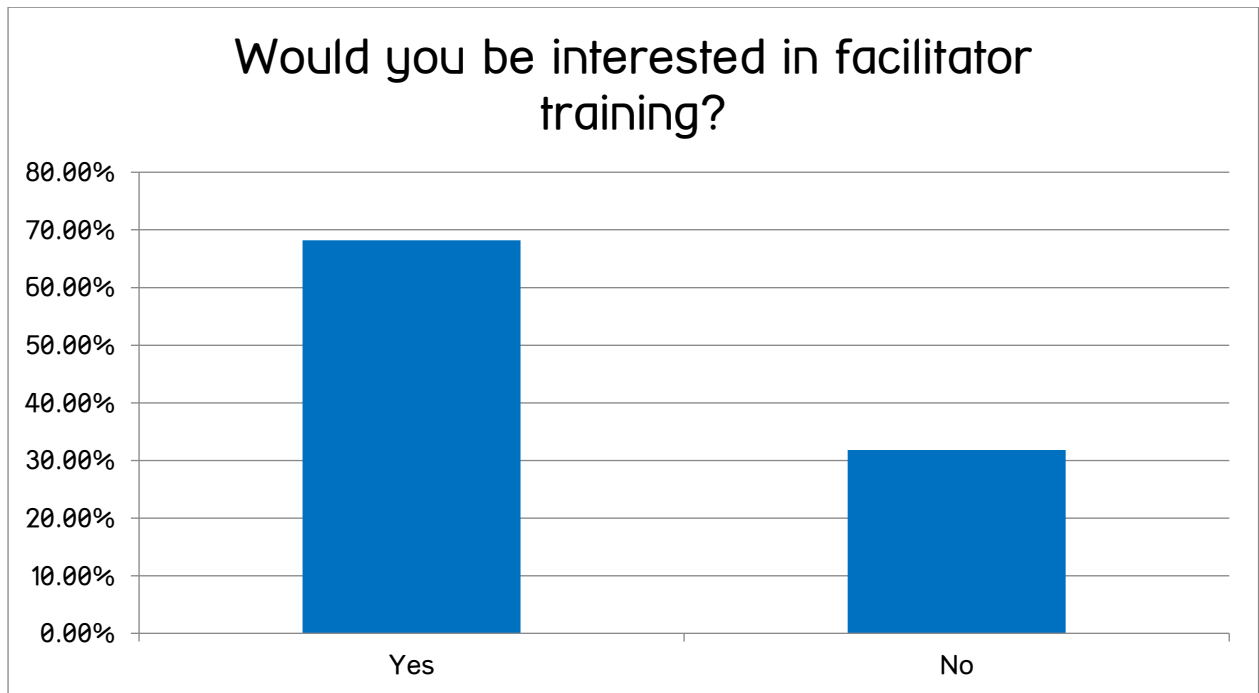
- More outcomes and sharing of resources, methods etc to help development in our roles
